

MEDICAL CRITERIA FOR ENTRANCE INTO GLENBARD NORTH HIGH SCHOOL

Please note: The following information should be mailed to Glenbard North High School prior to August 1st.

Read carefully: Parent and health care provider must complete all necessary areas to complete the registration process.

I. SPECIAL HEALTH EXAM AND IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION:

Prior to the opening of school, each 9th grade student **MUST** present proof of having immunizations and a health examination (physical) in accordance with Section 27-8.1 of the Illinois School Code and the rules and regulations of the Illinois Department of Public Health.

****Only the new 11-2015 version of the physical form will be accepted for the school year 2018-2019.****

IF THE STUDENT DOES NOT FURNISH A COMPLETED HEALTH EXAMINATION AND PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION BY AUGUST REGISTRATION, THE STUDENT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION PROCESS, BUY BOOKS, OR ATTEND CLASSES.

Complete immunization history:

- a) All immunization dates must be filled in and signed by health care provider.

Required immunizations include:

- a) One Tdap dose, regardless of the interval since the last DTaP, DT or Td dose.
- b) Polio booster after the age of 4.
- c) Hepatitis B Series (3 immunizations).
- d) **Two** doses of measles, mumps, rubella vaccine (MMR).
- e) **Two** doses of varicella vaccine or proof of chicken pox disease.

Other Requirements:

- a) **Parent must complete and sign the Health History portion.**
- b) A physician licensed to practice medicine (MD or DO), a physician's assistant (PA), or an advanced practice nurse (APN) must examine the student.
- c) A "diabetic screening" (BMI) is **required** and must be filled out by your physician.
- d) Physical exam must be completed within one year of entrance into 9th grade (**on or after 8-16-16**).
- e) **THE CERTIFICATE OF CHILD HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM IS ADEQUATE FOR ALL SPORTS FOR ONE YEAR, BUT A SPORTS PHYSICAL FORM (ISHA) DOES NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL ENTRY.**
- f) A TB skin test is suggested, but not required.
- g) If applicable, please provide an Asthma Action Plan to the Health Office. A sample is on the 'parent' page of the GBN website.
- h) **KEEP A COPY OF THE PHYSICAL AND IMMUNIZATION RECORD FOR YOUR FILE.**

II. DENTAL EXAMINATION:

- a) Strongly recommended, but not required.

III. VISION EXAMINATION:

- a) Strongly recommended, but not required of an Illinois resident.
- b) **All non-Illinois resident** children in kindergarten or upon first entry into an Illinois school beyond kindergarten (i.e. grades 1-12) are required to have an eye examination. This requirement includes students from public, private and parochial schools.
