ONLINE COURSE ENROLLMENT: GBN students will once again be selecting their courses for the 2019-20 school year ONLINE. Students will log in to their Student PowerSchool Account to enter their course selections beginning December 3, 2018 and ending January 7, 2019. School counselors will meet individually with students to review and finalize course selections in January.

BALANCE: When choosing courses, please take into consideration the level of courses your teachers recommended and the amount of balance in your school year with rigor of classes and co-curricular commitments such as clubs and athletics.
