Dear Glenbard North Parent or Guardian:

Welcome to the 2019-20 school year! We are looking forward to working with your student to make this year successful and rewarding! The information included in this packet will make the process as simple and convenient as possible. As you complete the registration materials in this packet, please keep the following items in mind:

Online Registration & Payment - Online registration will be available July 8<sup>th</sup> through August 1<sup>st</sup> Please follow the system prompts to register your student and pay your fees online by August 1<sup>st</sup> to realize your prompt pay discount of \$35 (instructions enclosed). Note: If you do not have internet access, computers are available at school during summer hours and your local library has computers available. Registration payments made after August 1<sup>st</sup> will pay the full registration fee of \$235. Registration and payment of fees are required prior to students receiving instructional materials and schedules during back-to-school week.

**Back-To-School Week** – Back-to-school week will occur August 6th through August 8th. It is important that students attend on their scheduled day. During back-to-school week, students will receive their class schedules, transportation information and have their ID/yearbook pictures taken. Freshmen will also receive PE uniform/lock and their iPad, along with training.

**Notification System** – Glenbard has implemented a new notification system to improve communication with our families. Please make sure that you complete this section as part of the registration process to ensure we have your current contact information.

AP Exam Timeline: The College Board has changed its timeline for ordering AP exams for 2019-2020. Specifically, exams will need to be ordered and paid for by November 15, 2019. The fee for each AP Exam remains at \$94 per exam; \$142 for AP Seminar and AP Research exams. Exams ordered late between November 16 and March 13 incur an extra \$40 late fee. More information will be provided from school staff once school commences, however, we wanted to make you aware of this change now.

# **REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES**

**FEES & REGISTRATION:** Glenbard utilizes an on-line registration process for families. Please refer to the enclosed "On-Line Registration" flyer contained in this packet for instructions. Both parent/guardian and student will be required to approve on-line policies and terms/conditions. Glenbard's Student Fee Schedule is located under the Parents section of the website.

### The required annual fees for all Glenbard students are:

- \$235 Registration Fee (Prompt pay fee of \$200 if paid in full by August 1, 2019)
- \$189 iPad Rental Fee (Juniors-Seniors)
- \$149 iPad Rental Fee (Freshmen-Sophomores) as a result of reduced cost from our vendor
- \$85 Digital Curriculum Fee

<u>Deadline</u>: On-line registration and payment must be completed **by Thursday, August 1st**. Registration and payments received after this date will pay the \$235 Registration & Fee charge versus the prompt pay fee of \$200.

**Registration & Fees**: The Registration and Fees charge includes registration, all course fees, student activity pass and digital handbook.

<u>Supplies - Required</u>: PE uniform and & lock will be provided to all <u>incoming freshmen</u> at Back-to-School Week and will be directly billed (\$24) to you for on-line payment. If needed, returning students will be able to purchase PE uniforms and lock once school is in session.

**Optional Fees:** The Athletic participation fee is \$150 per student, per year. The fee allows your student to participate in unlimited sports. In addition, yearbooks are available for purchase through the on-line registration & payment process. Students that sign up for the Behind the Wheel portion of Drivers Education, will be charged \$350. Parking passes are limited and the annual fee is \$200.

<u>PAYMENT OF FEES:</u> It is the policy of the Glenbard Board of Education that prior to the first official day of class students are expected to have paid fees and course materials in full. Payments are due by August 1<sup>st</sup> for families to realize the prompt-pay discount of \$35 and to ensure that your student can participate in Back-to-School Week. The on-line registration process will guide you through the registration and payment process. Families that cannot pay in full due to financial circumstances should refer to the Financial Assistance Programs referenced below.

<u>PAYMENT PLAN:</u> Glenbard offers a 4-pay, payment plan that allows you to pay your fees over the course of the school year. A \$7 convenience fee will apply. <u>IMPORTANT:</u> If you want the optional Athletic Participation Fee to be included in your payment plan, you must select this fee when you register online.

### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS:**

National School Breakfast and Lunch Program - (Free or Reduced Meals): Families that are eligible for the National School Breakfast and Lunch Program (Free or Reduced Meals) must apply <u>each</u> year for approval. Applications for the program can be made via our newly developed on-line application form contained within the Parents section of the website, under Financial Aid - Lunch and Breakfast Program. A link to our PowerSchool system and instructions will be provided at this site. If you believe you are eligible, please complete the on-line application form for submission. If you have questions regarding this program, please contact the Assistant Principal for Student Services Office.

<u>Waiver of School Fees:</u> Families that are eligible for waiver of school fees must apply <u>each</u> year for approval. Applications can be completed during Summer Extended Evening hours through the Office of the Assistant Principal for Student Services. School fee waiver information is contained within the Parents section of the website, under Financial Aid - School Fees. Application forms are available at the school. As part of the waiver application process, you will be required to sign up for the 8-payment plan. <u>This plan will remain in place in the event you are not approved for waiver of fees.</u> **IMPORTANT:** If you want the optional Athletic Participation Fee to be included in your payment plan, you must select this fee when you register online.

**Extended Summer Hours:** Daytime and evening hours are available this summer to apply for the Fee Waiver and on-line Free or Reduced Breakfast and Lunch programs. Staff will be available until 8:00 p.m. to assist you with the application process on July 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup>, and 31<sup>stt</sup>. Please call **630-653-7000**, after July 1<sup>st</sup> for further information.

### **TECHNOLOGY:**

<u>All incoming freshmen</u> will be issued an iPad to manage coursework. The annual rental fee for the iPad, case, insurance and loaner program is \$149 per year<sup>1</sup>, per student. Freshmen should look for more details on the "Freshmen Back-to-School Day" page of this packet. Freshmen & sophomore students are eligible for this fee due to the reduced cost of the iPad from our vendor.

Returning students that were issued an iPad for the 2018-19 school year are responsible for maintaining their device in good working order and will use their device for the upcoming 2019-20 school year. Returning students are expected to bring their device to Back-to-School Week for an 'iPad readiness' inspection. Students should run all software updates in advance to help expedite this process. Returning juniors and seniors will continue to be billed the \$189¹ per year, iPad rental fee.

<sup>1</sup>After the family has made 4 annual rental payments over the student's career at Glenbard and the student's account is paid in full, the device will become the property of the student. In other words, this is a rent-to-own program.

<u>Digital Curriculum/App Fee:</u> Students will also be required to pay an \$85 annual digital curriculum/App fee that covers the costs of all digital curriculum (digital textbooks, digital novels, digital workbooks) and applications (Schoology, our learning management system, etc.) that the student will use for their coursework.

Note: Certain courses may still require non-digital materials (hard-bound textbooks, paperback novels, or workbooks). If your student is provided these non-digital materials, they will be provided at <u>no additional charge</u>. Textbooks must be returned by the student in good condition at semester end (semester classes) or by year end (year-long classes), or fines could apply.

You are only permitted to take part in Back-to-School Week during your scheduled time. Please see schedule included in this packet. \*Note that due to iPad training, freshmen should plan to remain at Glenbard North for approximately 1½ hours after their scheduled time.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

<u>ATHLETICS:</u> Athletic registration information is included in this mailing. Athletic participation fees are \$150 per year, per student. Payment of the fee allows your student to participate in <u>unlimited sports</u> for the year. Note: You must register your student for school prior to registering your student for a sport.

**BELL SCHEDULES**: The schedules can be found in the digital student handbook or viewed on-line at www.glenbardnorthhs.org under the "Students" tab.

### **BUS TRANSPORTATION:**

<u>Providers</u>: Glenbard contracts with **First Student** for regular education transportation services. **Hopewell Inc.** provides transportation services for our special education transportation needs.

<u>Routes</u>: Glenbard uses transportation routing software to lower transportation costs and increase efficiency. Bus routes may be different from one school year to the next as routes are re-evaluated. Please look for bus information at Back-to-School Week in August. Route information for your student will also be available on-line, on your school website.

Student ID - Ridership Requirements: Students are required to present upon request their student ID to any bus driver or Glenbard staff member. Students not able to produce their ID will be required to receive a temporary pass to ride the PM bus. Students not able to produce their ID will be referred to the Deans' Office for appropriate consequences. Students will be responsible for riding their designated buses. Bus drivers and school administrators will deny requests for students to ride other routes than previously assigned unless pre-approved by the Deans' office.

**GPS Bus Tracking**: Glenbard has decided to terminate the First Student **FirstView** Parent App for the 2019-20 school year due to limited use by students and parents, cost and concerns regarding accuracy of information. We will continue to assess this product over time and make a determination regarding reinstatement.

<u>AP EXAM TIMELINE:</u> The College Board has changed its timeline for ordering AP exams for 2019-2020. Specifically, exams will need to be ordered and paid for by November 15, 2019. The fee for each AP Exam remains at \$94 per exam; \$142 for AP Seminar and AP Research exams. Exams ordered late between November 16 and March 13 incur an extra \$40 late fee. More information will be provided from school staff once school commences, however, we wanted to make you aware of this change now.

<u>FOOD SERVICE:</u> District 87 is pleased to partner with Sodexo, Inc. for our cafeteria service. Important information regarding Sodexo, menu offerings, on-line prepayment instructions for student breakfast and lunch is available in the Parents section of the website under "Food Service". We encourage you to visit <a href="https://www.MySchoolBucks.com">www.MySchoolBucks.com</a> to sign up for the prepayment option. The system is easy to use and provides parents with management options such as auto-refill, balance review, low-balance warning email, and visibility to items purchased by your student. <a href="https://www.myschoolBucks.com">Students can purchase breakfast and lunch using debit or credit cards.</a>

INSURANCE: District 87 provides "school-time" accident insurance protection for your student as part of its current insurance program. "School time" includes the school day while your student is attending academic school sessions and up to one hour before and one hour after regular classes. Your student is protected during school-sponsored activities as well, which further includes travel directly or indirectly and uninterruptedly to and from such school activity. Note: This coverage does not include interscholastic tackle football. Benefits are secondary to all other collectible insurance policies. Accidents or injuries must be reported to the appropriate teacher, coach, trainer, or nurse as soon as possible. Accidents that are not reported within 30 days of the accident will not be covered by the insurance carrier. Medical insurance is the responsibility of parents. This insurance program is for "school-time" accidents only. Optional coverage can be purchased for two programs: 24-Hour Optional Coverage and Grade 9-12 Interscholastic Tackle Football. Insurance brochures are available during Back-to-School Week or can be received by calling the school.

### **MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS (PHYSICALS):**

**Freshmen Only**: All freshmen and transfer students must provide a completed physical with required immunizations to the School Nurse by August 1, 2019. The physical exam must be completed within one year of entrance into 9th grade. Students will not be permitted to participate in Back-to-School Week, unless the School Nurse has received the required Health Exam and Immunizations. If you have questions, please call (630)653-7000.

**Seniors Only**: All seniors will need to provide proof of receiving the Meningitis Vaccine to the School Nurse by August 1, 2019. Without proof, your student will not be permitted to pick up his/her schedule.

**PANTHER NEWS:** Panther News will be sent electronically to the email address you provide in PowerSchool. This provides information on current events, achievements and other topics relevant to the Glenbard North Community.

PICTURES: Yearbook and ID photos are taken at Back-to-School Week. Students should dress neatly and in good taste.

RESIDENCY VERIFICATION: All families must verify residency each year prior to registering for school. Residency verification was due June 14<sup>th</sup>. Glenbard utilizes an electronic residency verification process and the majority of our families were electronically verified. However, if we could not electronically verify your residency, you should have received a letter in the mail from us in May, requiring you to verify residency in person or by mail by the due date referenced above. Residency procedures are located in the Parents section of our website, under the Residency Verification section. Verification of residency protects all of our families and ensures that only students that live in our school district boundaries attend Glenbard schools. It is illegal to attend school in a district where you are not a resident. Contact the Assistant Principal for Student Services (APSS) at school for more information.

**STUDENT ID REQUIREMENTS:** Students are required to carry, and present upon request, their student ID to any Glenbard staff member. Student IDs are required for entry to the building, to get on the bus, lunch purchase, library and lab check in, etc.

**STUDENT SCHEDULES:** Final schedules will be provided to your student at Back-to-School Week. Counselors will be available on a limited basis for questions beginning August 6<sup>th</sup>.

**TECHNOLOGY CENTER OF DUPAGE (TCD):** The first day of class for TCD is Friday, August 16, 2019. TCD students will be required to be in attendance at Glenbard North for the full day on August 14th & 15th, unless excused by parent or guardian.

<u>YEARBOOK:</u> Your Glenbard North Yearbook can be purchased as part of the on-line registration and payment process. Please purchase the yearbook at this time to reserve your book! After school is in session you will also be able to reserve your yearbook through the online store available anytime at <u>www.shop.jostens.com</u>, or you may find a link to that site from www.glenbardnorthhs.org

# **Late Back-to-School option:**

In an attempt to provide opportunities for all students to be prepared for the first day of school, we will offer a late Back-to-School option on Thurs day evening from 4:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. This is for any grade level. Since this late opportunity is outside of the Back-to-School Week schedule, wait times may be long. Please note that iPad training will not be provided during this late session, and therefore freshmen and transfer students will not receive their iPads until after school begins if they do not attend on their scheduled day.

# FRESHMEN BACK-TO-SCHOOL DAY IPAD TRAINING

To support our freshmen when they receive their iPad in August, each student will be required to take part in a training program during their Back-to-School day. When you arrive at your designated time on August 7, 2019, your son/daughter will:

- 1. receive his/her schedule (provided all requirements for residency, physicals, etc. have been met)
- 2. proceed to the cafeteria and get yearbook and ID pictures taken
- 3. pick up PE uniform and lock

Once your son/daughter has completed the process above, they will exit the south cafeteria and proceed to the 1100 (Blue) hallway where they will receive their iPad and be directed to a classroom for training. The training will be conducted by one of our teachers with approximately 25 students per class. During the training, all students will learn the same content including:

- Basic Functions and Setup
- Mobile Device Management and App Downloads
- Review of Appropriate Use Policy
- GMail
- PowerSchool
- Schoology
- Google Drive Setup and Basics
- Notability Basics
- Digital Curriculum How to Use Redemption Codes/Logins for Online Texts

This training will last approximately 1½ hours, meaning that your son/daughter should plan on being at Glenbard North for approximately 2 hours total for the Back-to-School process per the schedule below. Although many parents prefer to walk through the cafeteria process with their children, parents are not expected to stay during the training. Parents and students should plan for a ride home 1½ hours after they complete the Back-to-School day cafeteria process. For those students that will need transportation and live 1.5 miles or further from Glenbard North, we will provide transportation to the middle schools. # **ATHLETIC REGISTRATION INFORMATION (2019 – 2020)**

# For your convenience, the first step in athletic registration is performed online.

Note: Prior to registering your student for a sport, you must have registered your student for school.

Please complete the following steps to register your student for a fall sport:

- 1. Log in to PowerSchool parent portal.
- 2. Read and agree to the agreements that appear on screen.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to register your student for athletics.
- 4. Stop in the Athletic Office to submit a current physical and to pick up a Gold Card. The Gold Card is then turned in (by the student) to the Coach on your first day of Tryout/Practice.

Beginning July 15, 2019, athletes can register and obtain Gold Cards in the athletic office for the fall season.

There are help files and video tutorials there to assist you. <u>Both parent/guardian AND student(s) will be required to be present during online registration to individually agree to handbooks, agreements, and terms & conditions.</u>
- 3. Review your information and your student's information. Submit changes if needed.
- 4. Register for a sport if you wish to pay for it on a payment plan.
- 5. Click on Student Fees to complete the process and make your Registration Payment online. If you would like to pay for athletics on a payment plan, your student must be registered for at least one sport before setting up a payment plan for registration fees. You must register and pay by midnight Thursday August 1st, 2019 to receive the discounted registration fee.
