During the past academic year it was my pleasure to work with so many of you. I look forward to future opportunities to work collaboratively with community members, teachers, and administration to create a place where our students may experience a positive, safe and enriching learning environment. As Assistant Principal for Student Services, I deal directly with issues related to the following:

Glenbard North continues to achieve a high attendance rate. Our overall attendance rate was 95% for the 2018-2019 school year. This amazing attendance rate could not have been accomplished without the support of our parents. Thank you for your continued efforts in getting your child to school daily. As we move into the new school year, please continue to encourage daily attendance. It is important that your child attend each class every day. Student attendance in class is not optional; it is a requirement. We at Glenbard North believe that regular class attendance increases the student's probability for success and fosters the development of self-discipline and responsibility. On days when your student must be absent from school due to illness or emergency family issues, it is required that you telephone 630-653-9092 to report the absence prior to 10:00am on the day of the absence. This number is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

P.R.O.W.L - Please Reach Out We Listen - 630-681-3192

Our P.R.O.W.L line is one way in which students can report bullying or other inappropriate behaviors. When students feel uncomfortable in school it affects their ability to learn. At Glenbard North High School, we want all our students to feel safe. Students are encouraged to "speak up" and tell an adult in the school when they feel uncomfortable or witness inappropriate behaviors such as bullying. If a situation is reported, the administration will investigate the claim, access its validity and handle it accordingly. Our hotline P.R.O.W.L - Please Reach Out We Listen gives students an opportunity to report unsafe or intimidating behaviors while remaining anonymous.

Finally, Glenbard District 87 hosts monthly parent meetings. These meetings offer great opportunities for parents to learn about "teen issues" from experts in the field of adolescence. Recently, we launched our Profile of a Graduate - a multi-faceted transformative movement that underscores six key competencies that we want every graduate to embody. Each competency is accompanied by descriptions of that particular attribute.

The descriptions were developed by department chairs from each of our schools, along with school and district administrators. We worked through several iterations and used resources from EdLeader21, a national network of educators implementing competencies into their systems.

In each month's newsletter, we will look at the descriptions that correspond to each competency. Today, let's look at the descriptions that accompany collaborates:

- * Takes responsibility for self and team through shared, focused leadership
- * Receives, provides and learns from constructive feedback
- * Values and understands mutual accountability to the mission
- * Optimizes digital tools to learn and grow with others
- * Is generous in sharing ideas with others

Think about the people you work with - aren't the above descriptions what you seek in coworkers, leaders and job applicants? Aren't they also the qualities you appreciate about those you volunteer with in parent organizations, service clubs and charitable organizations? These are the qualities our talented faculty and staff will help our students develop in high school and carry with them throughout life.

The make-up dates for seniors who did NOT take their formal senior yearbook portraits over the summer for the 2020 Aquilo are as follows: Monday, September 16th through Friday,

September 20th, 2019 from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. (Seniors must make an appointment whether it be a yearbook only session or up to three outfits for these dates.)

Portrait appointments must be scheduled in advance and will be taken during after-school hours in the Glenbard North High School Auditorium. Appointments for these dates can be made by calling Prestige Portraits at 630-910-6800 and selecting option #5. Given color and digital sizing concerns, be advised that Prestige Portraits is the ONLY photography studio authorized to take portrait pictures for the Glenbard North yearbook. Photographs or portraits taken elsewhere will NOT be accepted for publication in the 2020 Aquilo.

The final make-up date at Glenbard North High School for seniors who simply want to have their picture in the yearbook is Thursday, October 17, 2019 from 10:10 a.m. to 1:35 p.m. outside the student cafeteria, nearest the Attendance Office. This single picture is free and can be quickly taken outside the cafeteria during all lunch periods. Students should dress to impress for this photo.

(Please note that seniors who do not take advantage of these opportunities at Glenbard North need to contact Prestige Portraits directly and travel on their own to have their formal senior portraits or free single picture completed no later than October 17, 2019. Be advised that this is an ABSOLUTE deadline for seniors wishing to appear with their class in the 2020 yearbook and will NOT be extended.)

Once again, appointments for all the above dates can be made by calling Prestige Portraits at 630-910-6800 and selecting option #5.

The price for the 2020 Aquilo is \$60.00 from now through October 4th, 2019. This Back to School Offer includes free icons with the purchase of personalization messaging. The price will then increase to \$65.00 as of October 5th, 2019- through January 31st. Please note that there will be no additional yearbooks available after the January 31st, 2020 deadline.

Orders for yearbooks, which can **ONLY** be completed online, may be placed by accessing the yearbook icon located on the Glenbard North High School homepage, then choosing Students, and then Resources and Files.
