ONLINE COURSE ENROLLMENT: GBN students will select their courses for the 2020-21 school year ONLINE. Students will log in to their Student PowerSchool Account to enter their course selections beginning December 2, 2019 and ending January 6, 2020. School counselors will meet individually with students to review and finalize course selections in January.

BALANCE: When choosing courses, please take into consideration the level of courses your teachers recommend and the amount of balance in your school year with rigor of classes and co-curricular commitments such as clubs/athletics.
