

Transfer Student Health Requirements

High school transfer students from Illinois:

1. Copy of your 9 th Grade DHS Physical from your former school.
2. Immunization Records Completed on the 9 th Grade Physical Form. If vaccines are needed an appointment card from a Medical Provider for completion within 30 days of first day attendance must be presented before the student will be allowed to attend.
3. Dental Exam if transferring as a freshman.

Transfer Student from out of state, OR out of the country entering an Illinois school for the first time:

1. Physical Exam on an Illinois Department of Health Services (DHS) form. The exam must be completed within one year prior to the date of entry.
2. Immunization Records Completed and signed by medical provider on the Physical Form. If vaccines are needed an appointment card from a Medical Provider for completion within 30 days of first day attendance must be presented before the student will be allowed to attend. See back page for Vaccine Requirements.
3. Eye exams (by an ophthalmologist or optometrist) are required for students entering an Illinois school for the first time.
4. Dental Exam if transferring as a freshman.

If you are a student returning to Illinois:

1. Copy of your 9 th grade IDHS (Illinois Department of Human Services) Physical Exam. The exam must have been completed within one year prior to the date of 9 th grade entry to an Illinois school.

2. Immunization Records Completed on the 9 th Grade Physical Form. If vaccines are needed an appointment card from a Medical Provider for completion within 30 days of first day attendance must be presented before the student will be allowed to attend.

3. Dental Exam if transferring as a freshman. Students may not attend school until Health Requirements are met.
