We want to inform you that several individuals who were at Glenbard North High School on

**November 22 and 23, 2021** tested positive for COVID-19. We have coordinated with the health department and are working to identify anyone who had recent contact with the individual in order to minimize the spread of infection in our school and community. *There is no need for individuals who have not been identified as close contacts to quarantine*. However, we encourage everyone in our school community to continue to monitor their health and stay at home if they develop symptoms. Symptomatic persons should contact their health care provider to determine a plan of care and discuss testing. If any individuals who were considered in close contact, they will be notified directly by a member of the health services team and advised to quarantine and report any changes to their health status to their medical provider and the school.

The health and safety of our students and staff is a top priority for the district. Our custodial staff will clean as necessary any affected areas following CDC and public health guidelines.
